Personnel Updates:

Mrs. Piper is stepping away from early AM Kids Corner (KC) on March 14th. We have hired Adam Audette who will step in as soon as his paperwork is complete and Maggie Amos will join him. Mrs. Cindy Amos will remain in place to train and teach the remainder of the year.

This fall Cindy will join the expanded PreK wing for before care as well as teach the Threes Class, and Maggie will leave to attend MSU and pursue a degree in graphic design! Because Cindy is transferring to the expanded wing, we will need to hire a second person for AM KC this fall for Grades K-5.

Other hiring needs:

- Our very own Alyssa Gray is also expanding her family this summer so we are searching for a long term first grade substitute teacher. We will need someone beginning on August 18 for 8-10 weeks.
- We will also need an early elementary teacher.
- Since we are expanding our PreK wing, we will need <u>two more staff members</u> to assist the PreK Threes team with afternoon daycare and afterschool care. The hours may be flexible but to give you an idea the need will be about noon-5:30 M-Th and noon-3:45 on Friday. I believe the new team will join Cindy Amos and Disa Askelson who will provide early morning care and teach the Threes class. Offering before and after PreK care will depend on community need.
- We will need a PreK Director to assist our current Director with before and after school care schedules, daycare licensing needs, GSRP and Threes PreK licensing needs, among other tasks.
- If GSRP Fours enrollment is high, we will open a third GSRP Fours classroom and will need a lead teacher and an assistant.
- We will likely need a couple of building paraprofessionals.

Intervention assistance + Title 1 Federal Funds:

As a Title 1 school, we utilize Title federal funds to hire and train para supports so they can assist teachers with specific, ongoing, lesson interventions each day. We use testing screeners and weekly checks to determine when students are able to move into another group to receive what they need. We are very fortunate to have many para supports, plus a full time Literacy Coach/Title 1 Coordinator, Ms. MacVicar, and a one day per week math coach, Mrs. Paige-Gruber, to assist paras, teachers, and students with helping our kiddos get what they need! If any parent would like to see the specific intervention materials we use, reach out to the office and we can give you a walk-through of the materials.
