# A review of School Hours:



### School begins at 8:40 and ends at 3:45.

It is in the best interest of your child to have him or her promptly at school to start on time so they can enter with their friends, unpack, and begin their day.



Kids who have a smooth start to their day without feeling rushed tend to be more successful in school and build stronger friendships.

Similarly, students that are allowed to stay until the end of their school day feel better prepared for starting the next morning, strengthen their academic learning, and they enjoy a few minutes to be social at the end of their day, which builds stronger relationships. Fifth grade safeties also have some leadership assignments at the end of their day which not only assists the younger students with dismissal but builds strong leadership skills as well.

Lastly, maintaining a schedule helps students to develop a sense of time and schedule accountability.



#### Meals:

Students may now receive one free breakfast and one free lunch, but you must still complete the free/reduced info sheet that went home. There is still a charge for milk, which is .75 and water is 1.00.



#### LABELS:

Please label your child's jackets, tennis shoes, boots, etc. Your child will need tennis shoes for P.E. class three times each week. You can have your child wear them on P.E. days or send in an extra pair to keep in their locker.
